*** Ongoing & Past Projects ***

1. **Townsite Act** – No New Update – We’re working on design and explanation for our request regarding the sedimentation pond/snow storage area to be presented to Forest Service.
2. **WWTP Funding** – Looks like we’ll be receiving \$50,000 in capital outlay funding from this past legislative session.
3. **Water Trust Board (WTB) Kachina Storage Tank and Clean Water State Revolving (CWSRF) Waste Water Treatment Plant Loan Doc’s** – Update – Received all loan documents for both of these funding sources. Staff will review and then present to the Mayor for signature.
4. **WWTP Upgrades** – Everything is installed. Still need the electrical hooked up to VFD drive for the WAS pump.
5. **State Road 150** – Acting District Engineer elevated to NM DOT Secretary, so the Secretary is now aware of the issues with 150. Some repairs have taken place and received a little feedback that it’s a little better now. Village staff will continue to follow up to see if more repairs are possible.
6. **Salary Survey** – In process. Staff performing reviews of Mike Swallow’s reworked the job descriptions, most reworked job descriptions have been reviewed and sent back. Mike Swallow will look to start pulling pay comparisons.
