- 1. **Townsite** Act No New Update We're working on design and explanation for our request regarding the sedimentation pond/snow storage area to be presented to Forest Service.
- 2. **WWTP Funding** Looks like we'll be receiving \$50,000 in capital outlay funding from this past legislative session.
- 3. Water Trust Board (WTB) Kachina Storage Tank and Clean Water State Revolving (CWSRF) Waste Water Treatment Plant Loan Doc's Update Received all loan documents for both of these funding sources. Staff will review and then present to the Mayor for signature.
- 4. **WWTP Upgrades** Everything is installed. Still need the electrical hooked up to VFD drive for the WAS pump.
- 5. **State Road 150** Acting District Engineer elevated to NM DOT Secretary, so the Secretary is now aware of the issues with 150. Some repairs have taken place and received a little feedback that it's a little better now. Village staff will continue to follow up to see if more repairs are possible.
- 6. **Salary Survey** In process. Staff performing reviews of Mike Swallow's reworked the job descriptions, most reworked job descriptions have been reviewed and sent back. Mike Swallow will look to start pulling pay comparisons.
