4. **NEW BUSINESS**

B. Consideration to Approve Resolution No. 2018-352 A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE VILLAGE'S EFFORTS TO INCREASE THE SAFETY OF VEHICLE TRAFFIC ENTERING AND LEAVING THE VILLAGE OF TAOS SKI VALLEY (Councilor Brownell joined the meeting.)

Councilor Bennett, Public Safety Committee Chair, presented an agenda item at the February 13, 2018 Regular Council meeting concerning traffic safety in general with regards to speed limits, road signage and road markings in the Amizette area of the Village. The Mayor and Council were unanimously in favor of having a resolution drafted that further outlined and addressed the concerns, which could be presented to NMDOT to request further action.

A. Approval of Staff's Recommendation to Enter into a Contract with RMCI for the Kachina Water Tank Construction Project

A high elevation 250,000 gallon water tank that will service the "Blue Zone" in the Kachina area has been discussed over the past twenty years or more, and in the past five years has become a priority for the Village of Taos Ski Valley. The Village applied for funding through the Water Trust Board and received grant, loan, and matching funds for this project.

The Request for Proposals was advertised for the required amount of time per State procurement requirements. The Village Administrator briefed the Mayor and Council at the February 13, 2018 regular Council meeting that the Village received three bids. The bid opening was on February 9, 2018. The bids, in the order they were received, were: Integrated Water Services at \$2,434,449.00, TLC Plumbing & Utility at \$3,054,411.50 and RMCI at \$2,121,744.25. TLC Plumbing & Utility's proposal had to be rejected for missing a required form.

FEI Engineers, the Village's contracted engineering firm, performed a detailed review of the two qualifying proposals and recommended to Village Staff that the contract be awarded to RMCI. Village Staff concurs. All State procurement procedures were adhered to as part of this process.
