CALLING FOR A VILLAGE OF TAOS SKI VALLEY TAX INCREMENT DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER ELECTION TO BE HELD ON JUNE 4, 2019

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Section 5-15-8 NMSA 1978, the Village of Taos Ski Valley Tax Increment Development District Board wishes to hold an election to elect two (2) board members of the Village of Taos Ski Valley Tax Increment Development District Board (the "Board").

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Village of Taos Ski Valley Tax Increment Development District Board:

- **Delegation of Authority.** The Village of Taos Ski Valley Tax Increment Development District (TIDD) Clerk is hereby delegated the authority to take all actions necessary to conduct an election of new members of the Board on June 4, 2019. Polls will open at 9:00 a.m. and close at 4:00 p.m.
- Section 2. <u>Date of Election</u>. The election shall be held on June 4, 2019. The TIDD Clerk shall follow the Election Procedures in NMSA Chapter 1 Article 24 Special Election Procedures.
- Section 3. Call and Notice for Village of Taos Ski Valley Tax Increment

 Development District Board Member Election. The TIDD Clerk shall call
 for Board Member Election by notice to be posted in at least three (3) public
 places within the District Boundary of the TIDD and published in full once a
 week for at least two (2) consecutive weeks before the date of the Election in
 the Albuquerque Journal or the Taos News or another newspaper of general
 circulation within the TIDD. The Notice of Board Member Election shall be
 published in English and Spanish in substantially the following form:

The TIDD Clerk shall conduct by mailed ballot any special election. Upon calling of an election by mailed ballot the TIDD Clerk shall send each voter of the relevant jurisdiction an absentee ballot along with a statement that there will be no polling place for the election. The voter shall not be required to file an application for the absentee ballot. The ballot shall be mailed to each voter on the twenty-eighth day before the election or as soon as is practicable thereafter. The return envelope for the ballot shall be postage-paid. Mailed ballot elections shall be used exclusively for voting in a special election. The election requirements of the TIDD Act, NMSA 5-15-8, shall be followed.

The TIDD Clerk shall prepare a voter list of 4 registered electors residing within the District and owners of property within 5 the District from the lists provided by the County Clerk and County Assessor. 6 7 The TIDD Clerk is hereby authorized to utilize other available resources to determine the names and addresses of resident qualified electors if 8 9 necessary. 10 Section 7. **Ballot.** The TIDD Clerk shall prepare and provide a form of ballot containing 11 the names of the eligible nominees by May 7, 2019 and make ballots 12 available to prospective voters at the Office of the TIDD Clerk by not later 13 than May 7, 2019. Ballots shall be mailed to all qualified electors and 14 property owners on the twenty-eighth day before the election, which is May 15 7, 2019. Candidate names shall be placed on the ballot in the order in which 16 valid nominations were received.
