The 341 TSV Green Route - NON-WINTER is a Fare-Free bus

Serving Persons with Disabilities

All vehicles are wheelchair accessible. For qualifying persons with disabilities NCRTD also provides an ADA paratransit service within the City of Española and the Town of Taos. For all other routes outside those areas, the fixed route bus will "flex" up to 34 of a mile on paved and/or graveled roads for qualifying persons with disabilities. These are "origin to destination" transportation services for persons with disabilities who cannot use the fixed bus service.

Individuals who wish to be considered for this service will need to complete an application, have the information verified by a medical professional, and be certified by the NCRTD as ADA paratransit eligible. The bus operator will assist an individual to get on or off the bus, but will not load or unload the individual's personal belongings or carry-on items. If an individual needs assistance beyond this, he/she must be accompanied by a personal care attendant. Required personal care attendants ride free with the person they are assisting.
